RESOLUTIONS FORM

February 7, 2012 Precinct Caucus

STEPS TO CHANGE THE PLATFORM of the REPUBLICAN PARTY of MINNESOTA:

Resolutions that are passed at the **Precinct Caucus** will be forwarded to the **2012 BPOU Convention**.

The **BPOU Convention** votes on these Resolutions, requiring a simple majority to pass. Resolutions that are passed at the **BPOU Convention** are then to be forwarded to the **2012 Congressional District Convention** where they are voted on; a simple majority is required to pass.

Resolutions that are passed at the **Congressional District Convention** will then be forwarded to the **2012 State Convention** where they are voted on; where once again a simple majority is required to pass.

Resolutions that are passed at the 2012 State Convention are incorporated into the **Standing Platform** of the **Republican Party of Minnesota**.

The Standing Platform of the Republican Party of Minnesota has **9 PLANKS**. Before writing your proposed Resolution, indicate *which* PLANK your Resolution pertains to (review the accompanying **Platform Brochure** for current wording of the standing planks). If you feel your resolution does not fit in a specific plank, check the **"OTHER"** option:
